1) New Business-

- a) Steve Riker re: Major wetland impact application for Lot 14 Map 201
 - Project is to replace a dock that was washed away last spring. The property is owned to the mean high tide line.
 - The structure would include a 6'x6' access ramp, 6'x36' long pier with 6 wood-pilings, a 3'x5' gangway down to a 3'x20' float. This would sit on the mud at low tide so requires float-stop pilings to minimize impact. The gangway and dock are seasonal structures so would be removed for winter.
 - C. Griffith asked whether the pier could be extended to avoid the float sitting on the mud. S. Riker replied it would have to extend out more than 100ft.
 - The project will impact the saltmarsh which is considered high priority so it will have to be approved by D.E.S. and the governor's counsel.
 - They considered moving the location slightly for less impact but there seemed to be minimal benefit.
 - J. Couture moves to approve the project subject to D.E.S. approval. C. Griffith seconds, all in favor YES.

2) Administrative Business:

- a) Minutes 9/19/22- D. Mason motions to accept, C. Griffith seconds, all in favor YES.
- b) Treasurer's report 9/1-10/31/22- J.Couture motions to accept, C. Griffith seconds, all in favor YES
- c) D. Mason stated that the selectmen approved the budget for 2023

- a) The Chick property consisting of 94 acres that spans the railtrail was sold at auction 11/11/22. L. Hill was told by B. Hart of SELT that it was bought by a commercial developer who may intend to use it as his private estate. J. Couture stated that he has heard that it is not allowed to create a road to cross the rail trail
- b) Greenway Advisory Comm.- L. Hill was told by A. Watts that B. Hart had mentioned to her that SELT is considering re-instating the committee. She would be interested in being a member. L. Hill will talk to B. Hart.
