#### **ARTICLES CONTINUED**

### **Article 02: ERCSD Operating Budget**

Shall the District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant Shall the District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant, or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein totaling \$58,948,101? Should this article be defeated, the operating budget shall be \$58,337,579 which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. The School Board and Budget Advisory Committee both recommend \$58,948,101 as set forth on said budget. (Majority vote required)

#### Article 03: Collective Bargaining Agreement

To see if the school district will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Exeter Region Cooperative School Board and the Exeter Cooperative Paraprofessional Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

Fiscal Year Estimated Increase 2019 \$181.078 2020 \$118,918 2021 \$117,393 2022 \$119,324

and further to raise and appropriate \$181,078 for the current fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels. The School Board and the Budget Advisory Committee both recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required)

## Article 04: CRF for Synthetic Turf Replacement

To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of up to \$50,000 to be added to the Synthetic Turf Replacement Capital Reserve Fund previously established under the provisions of RSA 35:1 for YES 20 replacement of the synthetic turf field located at Exeter High School. This sum to come from the June 30 undesignated fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No amount to be raised from taxation. The School Board and the Budget Advisory Committee both recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required)
