## **ZONING QUESTIONS**

Are you in favor of the adoption of Zoning Amendment No. 1 as proposed by the Planning Board
for the Town Zoning Ordinance as follows: The intent of this change to the Town zoning ordinance
is to comply with a recently adopted NH State Law that requires municipalities to offer accessory
dwelling units in all zones that permit single family dwellings. The law also limits the nature of
restrictions municipalities can apply to such units. The proposed amendment comprehensively
revises our ordinance to provide for Accessory Dwelling Units in accordance with state law with
permissible restrictions and regulations.

- Are you in favor of the adoption of Zoning Amendment No. 2 as proposed by the Planning Board for the Town Zoning Ordinance as follows: Update to Shoreland Protection Ordinance. This change substitutes the term "ordinary high water mark" for "seasonal high water level" to clarify the level of the stream from which to measure the shoreline buffer. This change brings our reference line into compliance with the State of New Hampshire Shoreland Protection efforts and provides consistency and familiarity to the Board and to applicants. There are no changes to the actual distance or buffer requirements.
